## Choose Your Own Adventure PowerPoint

For this assignment you will be creating an original interactive story in PowerPoint that will allow the reader to choose his/her own destiny. The story needs to have the following features:

1. Each slide must give the reader at least three possible route choices.
2. The reader will choose one route by clicking on a button or hyperlink that will send them to the proper slide to continue the story.
3. The reader must make at least three choices before the story ends. Minimum of 20 slides.
4. Be sure to include graphics and animations in your story.
5. Include at least 3 sounds (not including transitions, find & insert other sounds to accompany your story).
6. Include transitions between slides and custom animation of your character(s).

### Specifications

Your story:

- Should have 20 slides (minimum, your story can be longer if you choose)
- Must include at least one piece of WordArt
- Must only advance when user clicks links a link
- Must have sounds that turn on automatically when a slide begins
- Must have a variety of backgrounds (colours & pictures)
- Must use text boxes
- Must have the current date on the title slide

Every page should have a minimum of at least:

- One sound
- One graphic
- One slide transition
- One custom animation

Other things to remember:

- Pages where story ends should link back to start
- Pages with a choice should have a link for each option (3)
